Travel List

Passport-to be valid for a period of 6 months beyond length of stay

Rifle papers-The SAPS website is www.saps.gov.za and has detailed information with regards to the temporary import of firearms into South Africa

Airline Tickets/Reservations

Cash/Travellers Cheques/Credit cards – majority of retail outlets accept all major credit cards for curio shopping and refreshments.

Clothing

Mornings and evenings from May to August can be cold whilst temperatures can rise to 25°C during mid day. Summer mid-day temperatures can reach 40°C.

4/5 hunting shirts of a neutral colour, preferably khaki, green, olive or camouflage.

4/5 Loose fitting pants or jeans

Comfortable boots or walking shoes, ankle high preferably for hunting. Ensure shoes are well worn as walking is an integral part of the safari.

Small back-pack

Gloves

Hat/Cap

4/5 underwear & socks

Swim suit

Light weight water proof jacket

Warm jacket

Shorts

Casual clothing for the evenings including fleece or jacket as it does get cold as the sun sets.

There is a daily laundry service.

Personal Gear

Personal toiletries & small medical kit , sunglasses, sunscreen, lip balm, medications for specific allergies, insect repellent, binoculars, camera/video, good supply of film, flashlight, 220-110 volt converter

Rifles & Ammunition

Rifle - Calibre of .300 upwards recommended for Antelope species

Ammunition - recommended 60 round per rifle

Shock proof Rifle case – Airline approved,
